2020 BEWA Conference

The 2020 BEWA Conference will take place on Monday 30 November at the Business School at the University of Western Australia, Nedlands. Registration will begin at 8:30 and the Conference will commence at 8.45 am sharp. All delegates need to complete an online registration using the following link and to print their own personal programs.

When you have completed your registration, you will receive an invoice from bewaconference@iinet.net.au within one week and will be considered to be registered when payment has been made.

This will be a **paperless** conference and will adhere to public health recommendations. Please note the following details (keep as a reference to take to the conference):

- At registration, your temperature will be taken and, should you be running a temperature, you will be asked to leave and any monies paid for the conference will be refunded.
- You will not be required to use a pen and sign in at registration – simply ensure that your name is ticked off on the BEWA delegate list.
- No conference bags will be issued – bring your own stationery – writing paper, pens, etc.
- At registration you will be given:
 - a personal bottle of hand sanitizer
 - a USB containing the conference presenters' notes and handouts.
- Bottled water will be available for your convenience.
- The Welcome and Keynote will be held in the Ernst & Young Lecture Theatre, which is accessed from the **outside** of the Business School.
- Social distancing will be maintained in all Sessions, i.e. using every second row and every second seat.
- Morning tea and lunch will be provided in individual boxes (by the same caterer as the last two years) and will be distributed outdoors on the grassed area adjacent to the Business School building.

Note: the Business School café is closed indefinitely so will not be available for you to purchase coffee, etc. BEWA is planning to provide a coffee truck at morning tea time where drinks will be provided to you free of charge.
